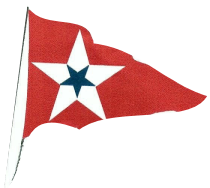

Hope to see many of you at the June 13th meeting,

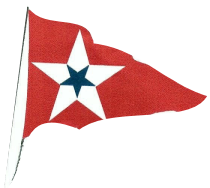

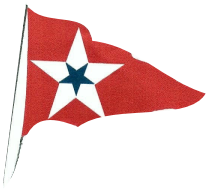
It is always a beautiful location but there should be better lighting in the parking lot upon leaving. Food was great. Great music but a little loud for inside small area.
